**1. Introduction**

Storetec Services Limited (referred to as “Storetec”, “we”, “us”, or “our”) have produced this policy to provide information about “cookies”, including; what they are, what type of “cookies” we use, what we use them for, and how you can manage them using the settings on our website.

**2. What are cookies?**

A cookie is a small text file that is used to store small pieces of information. They are stored on your device when the website is loaded on your browser. These cookies help us make the website function correctly, and to make it more secure, provide a better user experience, and to help us understand how the website performs and to analyse what works and where it needs improvement.

**3. How do we use cookies?**

As is standard across most popular online websites and services, we use both first-party and third-party cookies for several purposes.

First-party cookies are mostly necessary for the website to function correctly – they do not collect any of your personally identifiable data. These cookies will generally be categorised as “**necessary**”, and in most cases, you will not be able to disable them.

Third-party cookies are used to understand how the website performs and gather information on how you interact with our website, such as the pages you visit and share. These cookies help us provide you with a better and improved user experience, and to help speed up your future searches and interactions with our website.

#### 4. Types of cookies we use

We use a cookies for a variety of different reasons, and so we have provided a list of categories below to help your understanding of what each of them do.

You will not be able to disable 'necessary' cookies as they contribute to the basic functionality of the website in order to allow you to use it correctly.

Type	Description
<b>Necessary</b>	required to enable the basic features of the site, such as providing secure log-in or adjusting your consent preferences. These cookies do not store any personally identifiable information.

There are also a number of cookies you can choose to disable. If you disable these cookies, the website should still function as intended, however, please be aware that turning off certain cookies may affect your overall user experience:

Type	Description
<b>Functional</b>	these help perform certain functionalities, like sharing the content of the website on social media platforms, collecting feedback, and other third-party features.
<b>Analytics</b>	these are used to understand how visitors interact with the website. These cookies help provide information on metrics such as the number of visitors, bounce rate, traffic source, etc.
<b>Performance</b>	these cookies are used to understand and analyse the key performance indexes of the website which helps in delivering a better user experience for the visitors.
<b>Advertising</b>	these cookies are used to provide visitors with customised advertisements based on the pages you visited previously and to analyse the effectiveness of the ad campaigns.
<b>Unclassified</b>	these cookies will be listed as 'Others', and such cookies represent those that are being analysed and have not been classified into a category as yet.

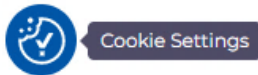
